Do you have a nose for news? Do you like the idea of reporting on location? Come join us for a week of reporting and exploring. The first day we will test our interview skills and camera techniques on location by exploring Henry Vilas Zoo with the camera gear. On days two and three we will report on location and gather news from around Sun Prairie. The final day is set aside for editing all the footage from the week. Snacks will be provided.

## ADVENTURES IN ANIMATION



Making a cartoon has never been easier! Discover how animators create animated cartoons and movies. Designed for students with a desire to learn, this workshop focuses on traditional stop-motion techniques and 2d animation techniques. Learn how to bring art to life with animation. Then add sound and special effects! We will also use cameras and iPad animation apps. Snacks will be provided.

## ADVENTURES IN MOVIE MAKING



Ready to make a summer blockbuster? Create a story idea with a production team, and then turn that concept into a script and storyboard. Students can either rotate project roles (spending time as a director, camera operator or actor) or they can choose to focus on improving their skills in one particular role. As a team students will create a movie from concept to completion while adding fun special effects, use of the green screen and a short trailer. Snacks will be provided.

## ADVENTURES IN RADIO



Discover the thrill of radio in the 103.5 The Sun studio! Learn how a real radio station works, practice on-air announcing, program your favorite songs and ask the questions that make great interviews. This workshop provides hands-on experience putting together radio productions in the studio and on location. This course is a great opportunity for young people who want to gain confidence on the microphone. Snacks will be provided.

## ADVENTURES IN PHOTOGRAPHY



We will begin with a "photo safari" around Sheehan Park exploring and using the digital cameras as we learn the basics of photography. We'll explore different subjects from nature, to people, to the abstract. Back in the "digital darkroom" we'll edit our photos with Photoshop and learn basic digital art techniques and graphic design. No special equipment is required, any point and shoot camera will work! We will provide cameras if you do not have one. Snacks will be provided.
