Topics include music automation, voice tracking, playing tracks/cuts from physical media, host a talk show, even taking phone calls!

This workshop covers what a producer needs to know while filming away from the studio. It consists of individual instruction on basic camera set-up, usage and techniques. Participation in this workshop is required to check-out equipment. You will learn the equipment that is available for check-out along with tips and tricks for shooting.

Editing a program and adding titles and credits creates a more finished, professional look. In this workshop, participants are given personal instruction on the use of video and computer software used to edit video while adding graphics and text to a program.
